

Dentist-in-Chief, Sinai Health System, Toronto

Applications are invited for a Dentist-in-Chief at Sinai Health System (SHS), a fully affiliated academic hospital of the University of Toronto, comprised of Mount Sinai Hospital, Bridgepoint Active Healthcare, the Lunenfeld-Tanenbaum Research Institute and Circle of Care. Sinai Health combines acute care, complex and rehabilitative care, primary care, home care, and other community-based services to create an innovative and integrated continuum of care, meeting the needs of complex patients.

The Dentist-in-Chief leads the Department of Dentistry, situated at Mount Sinai Hospital, with 45 faculty members. The Department's clinical programs include Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery; General Dental Care for Medically Complex Patients, including adults with disabilities; Oral Pathology and Oral Medicine; and Temporomandibular Joint Disorders/Craniofacial Pain. The Department also provides support to the Emergency Department and other Hospital Departments. The Hospital is a core site for training programs of the Faculty of Dentistry, University of Toronto, and supports key dental educational programs including hospital-based general practice residency, oral and maxillofacial surgery, oral pathology and oral medicine, periodontology and undergraduate dentistry.

Reporting to the President and CEO, the Chief is responsible for leading the Department in achieving excellence in clinical care, education and research. They are responsible for developing and implementing a vision and strategic plan for the Department, in alignment with Sinai Health's mission, vision and values. They will have superior leadership qualities, and be an excellent communicator, able to mentor junior faculty and foster partnerships. They will have a commitment to provision of the highest quality care, interprofessional and multilevel education, and a proven track record and/or commitment to research, education and quality improvement. They will have demonstrated the ability to create and maintain a workplace and learning environment that is equitable, respectful and safe for all staff, trainees and patients.

The successful candidate must have a DDS degree or equivalent, and be eligible to practice dentistry in Ontario. They should be recognized as a highly competent general dentist or specialist, and respected as a clinician, educator and administrator. Hospital dentistry experience preferred. They should also hold or be eligible for an academic appointment in the Faculty of Dentistry at the University of Toronto.

Remuneration for the role of Chief is commensurate with qualifications and experience, supplemented by clinical income. The position is for a 5-year term, renewable once based upon a successful review. The effective start date is January 1, 2022 or shortly thereafter.
